## ITINERARY

**ANCIENT ORIGINS TOUR OF TURKEY | SEPTEMBER 13—24, 2020**

**12 DAYS/11 NIGHTS**

**MEETING PLACE ISTANBUL INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**

Pick up point for start of tour is the arrival lounge of Istanbul's International Airport. On arrival, all clients will be given transfers to hotel in Istanbul regardless of arrival time or date. At the end of the tour all clients will be brought to Adiyaman Airport on the same shared transfer.

### **Day 1 - Sunday, September 13, 2020 Istanbul**

Arrival at Istanbul International Airport. Transfer to hotel. Evening lecture and orientation with Ancient Origins and special guest.  
Overnight in Novotel Bosphorus Hotel, Istanbul

**Day 2 - Monday, September 14, 2020**  
**Istanbul – Ankara**

After breakfast, visit the Sultanahmet district, called the “historical peninsula”. See the Blue Mosque, the most important mosque in Istanbul with its more than 20,000 handmade ceramic tiles and 200 stained glass windows. Visit Byzantine monuments including the St. Sophia Museum (Hagia Sophia, the former Byzantine Church), the greatest example of Byzantine architecture in Turkey. See also the Basilica Cistern, which was the main water provider for the ancient city of Constantinople, and the Byzantine Hippodrome where we will view beautiful obelisks and columns from the Egyptian, Greek, and Roman periods.

Transfer to the airport for a flight to Ankara.

**Day 3 - Tuesday, September 15, 2020**  
**Ankara Anatolian Civilization Museum - Gordion – Hattusa**

After breakfast visit the Anatolian Civilization Museum of Ankara, and see artifacts and reconstructions from Neolithic sites such as Çatalhöyük as well as the incredible bronzes from the Bronze Age sites of Alaca Höyük. Lunch in Ankara.

After lunch drive to Gordion (the tumulus of King Midas), one of the most important archaeological sites in Turkey. The metropolis enjoyed its golden age in the first millennium when it was the royal capital of the Iron Age Kingdom known as ‘Phrygia’ to the Greeks and ‘Mushki’ to the neighboring Assyrian Empire. Excavated in 1957, the mound of Midas is 300 meters in diameter and is 43 meters high. In the wooden chamber, the corpse of a man was found along with the remains of his last dinner. It still contains funerary furniture, possibly from Midas’ palace. Return to Ankara.

**Day 4 - Wednesday, September 16, 2020**  
**Hattusa - Alaca Höyük – Cappadocia**

Visit the ruins of the Hittite capital of Hattusa. See its green nephrite omphalos stone and sphinx gates. Lunch in Hattusa. After lunch journey on to the magnificent ruins of Alaca Höyük, a Hittite city with origins dating back to the Chalcolithic or Copper Age. Visit the museum, and see the site's extraordinary polygonal walls, similar to those in Peru, Easter Island, and ancient Egypt, as well as its own iconic Sphinx Gate. Drive on to Cappadocia and arrive at your hotel for a late dinner. Time permitting, evening presentation.

**Day 5 - Thursday, September 17, 2020**  
**Cappadocia**

After breakfast take a walk through the Red Valley with its varying types of rock formations and color, and rock-cut cave churches with beautiful frescoes and paintings. Stop for photo opportunities in this scenic lunar landscape of unique rock formations called "fairy chimneys" Lunch. Climb the Uchisar natural castle with its labyrinth of rock-cut rooms, and later visit the Goreme open-air museum. A UNESCO World Heritage site, it is the capital of Turkey's eastern province of Cappadocia. See its many rock-cut churches and beautiful art, some of which is very likely shamanic in nature, harking back to a prehistoric age.

**Day 6: Friday, September 18**  
**Urgup - Derinkiyu - Ihlara Valley**

Visit the enigmatic underground city of Derinkiyu, constructed in part at the end of the last Ice Age, and the tranquil Ihlara Valley, within which can be found various rock-cut churches containing well preserved religious art. Stop briefly at the 10,000-year-old archaeological site of Aşıklı Höyük, an important urban centre where beautiful obsidian items were manufactured during the Pre-Pottery Neolithic age.

**Day 7: Saturday, September 19**  
**Catalhöyük - Konya**

After an early breakfast set out for the ancient city of Konya in the south of the country for a tour around its archaeological museum, which includes spectacular treasures from Çatalhöyük and beautiful art from the Greek and Roman ages. On the way, stop for pictures at the Sultan Han, a large 13th-century Seljuk caravanserai located in the town of Sultanhanı, Aksaray Province. Lunchbox on the coach. Later, visit the famous prehistoric city complex of Çatalhöyük, over 9,000 years old. In the evening experience the breathtaking Mevlana Whirling Dervishes show at the nearby Mevlana Cultural Center.

**Day 8 - Sunday, September 20, 2020**

### **Konya – Şanlıurfa**

Travel throughout the day from Konya east into southeast Anatolia. Enjoy talks, discussions, and DVDs on the coach. There will also be regular convenience stops. Arrive at Şanlıurfa by mid-evening. Evening dinner at hotel.

**Day 9 – Monday, September 21, 2020**

### **Şanlıurfa - Göbekli Tepe – Harran**

Visit Göbekli Tepe, the world's oldest stone temple complex, constructed nearly 12,000 years ago. See its extraordinary rings of T-shaped standing stones with carved reliefs of birds, animals, and other abstract forms. Learn its history and place in the origins of civilization. After lunch, visit the ancient city of Harran, home of the ancient Sabaeans and Chaldeans, as well as the point of origin of the hermetic tradition. See Harran's ancient city mound, its Seljuk period castle, and also its compelling "astronomical tower," the possible inspiration behind the imagery of The Tower card in the Tarot pack. Dinner at the hotel.

**Day 10 - Tuesday, September 22, 2020**

### **Şanlıurfa - Göbekli Tepe - Şanlıurfa Museum**

Visit Şanlıurfa's Archaeological Museum in the morning to see the extraordinary display of artifacts from Gobekli Tepe. See also a full-size model of the site's fabulous Enclosure D, as well as the reconstructed stone temple of Nevalı Çori, which is 10,500 years old. Packed lunch. Afterward, visit the Pools of Abraham and birthplace of Abraham in the heart of the old city of Şanlıurfa. Later, make our second visit to Göbekli Tepe to get a real taste of this incredible site, this time for meditation and contemplation of the unfathomable motivations behind its construction at the end of the last ice age. Dinner at the hotel.

**Day 11 - Wednesday, September 23, 2020**

## **Cendere Bridge - Mount Nemrut - Arsemia – Adiyaman**

After breakfast in Şanlıurfa, depart north for Adiyaman province, one of the most sacred regions of southeast Turkey. Visit Karakus Tumulus, and also Cendere Bridge, one of the world's oldest surviving bridges, constructed during the reign of Roman emperor Septimus Severus (193-211). See also the ancient site of Arsemia, the summer capital of the Commagene kingdom and burial place of King Mithridates. See the largest rock inscription found in Anatolia, which describes the political and religious beliefs of the inhabitants, and view a stone stela showing King Antiochus I of Commagene shaking hands with the god Hercules.

At sunset, we visit Nemrut Dagi (Nimrod's Mountain), one of East Turkey's most spellbinding attractions. At its peak sits enigmatic statues of King Antiochus I of Commagene, as well as representations of various deities believed to be his ancestors. The views from the summit are sublime. (NOTE: it is a 20-30 minute walk up steps to reach the summit).

Drive to Adiyaman and Farewell Dinner.

## **Adiyaman**

Free morning in Adiyaman. Leave the hotel at about 12:15 to go to the airport to catch your flight back to Istanbul for completion of the tour. Flight arrives back into Istanbul airport at 15:45.
